Federal Update

PPP Flexibility Act

- 24 weeks instead of 8
- 60% on payroll, not 75%
- Forgiveness period extended to Dec 31st.
- Loan maturity is up to 5 years (new borrowers only)
- Extended deferral period. Payment only due after loan forgiveness is determined.
- Clarity when unable to rehire.

 - Assembly and Senate agreed to a proposal
 - Big 3 negotiation
- Small business impact
 - Fully funding small business assistance centers
 - Adding another \$50 million to Ibank
- DBO/DFPI expansion included in Gov but not legislative
