California's 2021 (v 2020) Legislative Session

2020

- Uncertainty is the name of the game
- Budget, budget, budget ⊗
- ☐ July 27 is when legislators go back to hear bills

2021

- Budget, budget, budget!!! \$75 Billion surplus and \$25 Billion from the CARES 2.0

Support for Governor's proposed budget

- > \$1.5 billion for three additional rounds of small business relief grants
- > \$100 million for IBank loan and guarantee programs
- > \$35 million for small business micro-grants in underserved communities
- > \$100 million for cannabis and \$55 million for farmers
- > \$7 billion for broadband (crucial for small businesses, especially rural ones)

Additions to the budget

- \$50 million for the Micro-Business Relief Fund (Street Vendor Recovery Fund)
- \$70 million to fund a state CDFI Fund
- 1072 budget and 1573 budget items
- \$36.5 Million in a One-Time Investment for Worker Ownership Transitions to Protect Small Businesses

Talking Points



Recovery Funds

- Liquidity for CDFI's and mission-based lenders.
- Grants for small businesses
- Debt payment relief
- Commercial rent / extend moratorium for evictions
