

# **CAMEO Academy - Special trainings**

- **WECAN:** hosted six cohort calls with topics selected by the participating organizations and provided advisory services to WBCs to increase their impact on marketing, fundraising, data collection, and other needs.
- Cooking Up for Success: created a 4-part series with the NY Immigration Coalition to train resource partners to understand entrepreneurship and the ecosystem of support for food business in the state of New York with 162 registrants
- How to Serve California Agriculture: in partnership with California FarmLink, delivered an 8-week train-the-trainer class in the fall with 28 people registered and a developed a facilitator's guide





## State Advocacy 2022

- Successful Budget = \$105.5 million for ecosystem
- Sponsored 1 bill
- Supported 17 bills
  - 11 signed into law
  - 6 died in the legislative process
- 9 of 17 bills we supported were priority bills
  - 6 signed into law
  - 3 died in the legislative process
- Continued increased exposure
  - Testified at 2 bill hearings as a witness
  - Carolina on the plenary stage at California Forward
